How will this course benefit me?

This Entry level English course will provide you with an access into adult learning in your local area. You will have the opportunity to improve your English as well as develop your confidence, improve your skills, help your family and make a contribution to your child's education.

What are the entry requirements?

For parents/grandparents/ carers with children at the school.

You will need a basic level of English.

Aim for 100% attendance

Be on time for classes and do regular homework.

What will I learn?

You will develop your English skills in speaking, listening, reading, writing and grammar for English at Entry level for everyday life, including:

- recognising where you need to improve your language skills and those that could be hindering your ability to support your child/ren with their learning
- • reading a local map to find your child/ren's school and complete school application forms
- understanding words used by your child/ren's teachers and asking questions about them
- finding information in a leaflet about making the most of parents' evenings

How will the course be delivered?

You will work in pairs, groups and individually. There will be group discussions, listening to taped conversations, completing activity sheets

How will my learning be assessed?

You will be assessed through tutor observation, task completion and Q & A. You will have an individual learning plan with personal targets that you will be working towards

What are the extra costs?

Please bring a pen, pencil and folder for your work

What can I progress to next?

You could progress to the next level general ESOL or English course depending on availability or local conversation club.
